



Year 10 Careers Programme

Work experience is an integral part of the Careers programme at Scone Grammar School and provides an opportunity for Year 10 students to gain an insight into life beyond the school. Our students have enjoyed the opportunity to spend their week in a variety of industries including architecture, law, engineering, veterinary, education, retail, hospitality and tourism, construction, hairdressing, information technology and finance. Students derive great benefit by organising their own placement, especially in the realms of communication and organisation.

In conjunction with their Work Experience, students also compile their resumes and portfolios over the year. Occupational Health and Safety is another topic discussed during their fortnightly Careers lesson and also the options for the end of Year 10. Traineeships, apprenticeships and progression to Year 11 are examined and subject courses looked at for students moving into Year 11.

Students in Year 10 visit the Maitland Careers Market, held in May each year. The Market provides an excellent opportunity for students to discover relevant information regarding post school options concerning universities, colleges, TAFE's, Defence Force careers, employment, apprenticeships and traineeships.
